Student / Parent Conduct Agreement

Students **must not leave any event venue, church facility or current location of group without the permission of event leadership.** If your student needs to leave early, a parent will be contacted for approval and transportation arrangements.

Dress: Clothing with alcohol, tobacco, satanic, and sexual slogans are not allowed. No short-shorts, halters, low cut tops, bare midriffs, or speedos will be permitted. Girl swimsuits must be a modest one-piece or a two piece with full coverage (no bikini tops). If there is exposure of stomach or not a modest suit, leadership may require a t-shirt to be worn over bathing suit.

We have zero tolerance for pranks, rough housing or fighting. We want everyone to have the best event experience possible and this behavior can ruin that. Pranks or fighting of any kind will have consequences that include contacting parent(s)/guardian(s) and possible dismissal from event at the expense of parents/student.

Students are to respect the belongings of others and the property and facilities of where the event/activity is taking place. Do not touch any item that you have not been consented to use. Student is responsible for the breakage of property that is not theirs.

Do not bring TVs, portable DVD players, radios, electronic games, laptops, electrical appliances (this does not include blow dryers and curling irons). Phones are permitted to events/activities but are to only be used for pictures and taking notes. If phone use is taking place when a student should be attentive or they are a distraction with their phone, they will be asked to put their phone away. If it continues, leadership has the right to remove phone from student at that time.

Tobacco products, vape pens or devices, alcohol, condoms, fireworks, knives, mace, or weapons of any kind – toy or otherwise are not permitted. No matches or lighters permitted. Weapons, pornography, drugs, firearms, and alcohol of any kind could be grounds for immediate dismissal.

There is **no PDA (Public Display of Affection)** between students. Students are asked to keep hands to themselves, which includes handholding, back rubs, hugging, laying on one-another, kissing and any other form of inappropriate behavior. We understand that some students may be in a relationship, but events/activities are not the appropriate place to show affection. If students of the opposite sex are discovered to be alone or behaving inappropriately, could be grounds for immediate dismissal.

Student agrees to show respect to all leadership and fellow students. Student also agrees to follow all rules/guidelines listed above and that may be added for a specific event/activity. If a student does not follow this conduct agreement, a parent may be called and/or the student dismissed from this event/activity. **Parent understands that they would be responsible to come get their student at their own expense.**

By signing this conduct form, you are confirming you have read through it's entirety and fully understand the type of conduct that is expected from all students. Parents are also signing to confirm they have read and talked with their student about their conduct for all future events.
